

Hygiene Concept

Status: 02.11.2020

1. Distance and circulation rules

- a. Access restrictions ensure that there is a maximum of one person per 10 square metres of visitor area. In order to maintain these distances, the concrete floor area is available as an alternative area (as long as the water level is low).
- b. A minimum distance of 1.5 metres per person is ensured, unless the applicable Sars-Cov infection protection ordinance provides otherwise. Appropriate path concepts are signposted and prefer the one-way regulations.
- c. Waiting areas (e.g. toilet facilities) are also provided with markings to maintain the minimum distance.

2. Individual personal measures

- a. All persons must disinfect their hands when entering the premises. Disinfectant dispensers are provided by the operator.
- b. Within the building structures, the wearing of mouth and nose covers is obligatory, as far as the Sars-Cov infection protection ordinance in the currently valid version prescribes this.

3. Measures related to the architecture

Contact surfaces are regularly cleaned and disinfected.

4. Ventilation concept

The architecture enables continuous ventilation of the building structures, which greatly minimises the aerosol load in rooms.

5. Organisation of the facility

Contact data of all persons (surname, first name, address, telephone number) as well as the period of the visit will be documented after consent has been obtained to enable contact persons to be traced and kept by the operator for a period of 1 month beginning on the day of the visit and subsequently destroyed in compliance with the DSGVO.

Processing of the data for other purposes is not permitted.
